Risk Assessment

- Equipment operations (e.g. forklifts, tractors, power take-offs, trucks, ATV, etc.)
- Ladders (Picking, Pruning, Tree training)
- Proper Handling of Chemicals/Pesticide re-entry
- Personal Hygiene
- Climate and Surrounding Conditions (e.g. personal hygiene, sunburn, poison oak/ivy, rashes, etc.)
- Injuries (e.g. back, eye, arm, leg injuries, muscle strains, lacerations, etc.)
- Personal Protective Equipment

Risk Mitigation

- Follow WA State Department of Labor and Industries Safety Standards for Agriculture.
- Training on Worker Protection Standards for proper handling of chemicals and PPE
- Training of Global Gap standards for personal hygiene
- Ladder training
- Equipment training for all machine operators
- Training on proper lifting techniques
- Safety meetings with employees and management
